Topic: The 21st Century International Governance Qualification - From Quality Enhancement to Excellence

The Chartered Governance Institute (CGI) founded in 1891 in the United Kingdom is a qualification awarding institute with a global membership of 30,000 across 80 countries.

To ensure its qualification and curriculum are fit for purpose for the 21st century business world, CGI undertook a two-year global review in 2015 and overhauled its qualification scheme.

The new Governance Professionals Qualifying Programme (CGQP) was established in 2017 with the creation of the Chartered Governance Professional qualification, which is parallel to the existing chartered Secretary qualification – leading to dual qualifications under the new Programme.

CGQP was formally launched in late 2019. In line with the completion of enhancement to achieve excellence, CGI has also reviewed and upgraded its quality assurance framework.
