Ir Francis Cheng is a scientist and an engineer with over 41 years of working experience in the power industry. He joined The Hongkong Electric Company, Limited (HK Electric) in 1979 and has since then worked as a Chemist and an Engineer before being promoted to the present management position. He had worked in Lamma Power Station, which is the only power station supplying electricity to Hong Kong Island, Apleichau and Lamma Island, for more than 37 years.

Ir Cheng graduated from the University of Hong Kong in 1977. He was a teacher in a secondary school for two years before joining HK Electric. His present capacity covers the electricity generation, transmission and distribution; system operations and information technology functions of HK Electric.

Ir Cheng is a fellow member of The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers and is currently a council member of the Institution. He is also a member of the Engineers Registration Board.

Ir Cheng has been a keen supporter of the Qualifications Framework (QF) under the Education Bureau of Hong Kong for more than 16 years. He was the chairman of the Industry Training Advisory Committee for Electrical & Mechanical (E&M) Services from 2011 to 2018 and is currently still a member of the committee. He has participated in various activities and taken up different roles in promoting vocational education and training (VET) in the E&M services industry. In the Honours List announced by the HKSAR Government on 1st July 2016, Ir Cheng was awarded a Medal of Honour for his contributions to the implementation of QF and promotion of VET.
