This accreditation report is issued by the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) in its capacity as the Accreditation Authority as provided for under the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Ordinance (Cap 592) (AAVQO). This report outlines the HKCAAVQ's determination, the validity period of the determination as well as any conditions or restrictions on the determination.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 In the academic year 2012/13, the Diploma Yi Jin (DYJ), then known as Yi Jin Diploma, was introduced in replacement of the former Project Yi Jin. DYJ aims to provide an alternate pathway for Secondary Six school leavers as well as adult learners to obtain a formal qualification for the purposes of further study and employment. The Federation for Self-financing Tertiary Education (FSTE) is commissioned by the Education Bureau to develop and administer the programme, and serves as the secretary to the DYJ Programme Management Committee (PMC). The Yi Jin Diploma programme was accredited by HKCAAVQ in August 2013 with a validity period of three years starting from the 2013/14 academic year to be operated by seven member institutions of FSTE.
- 1.2 Based on the Service Agreement, HKCAAVQ was commissioned by FSTE, on behalf of the seven member institutions (the Operators), namely
- (a) Caritas Institute of Community Education;
 - (b) Hong Kong College of Technology;
 - (c) Hong Kong Institute of Technology;
 - (d) Li Ka Shing Institute of Professional and Continuing Education, The Open University of Hong Kong;
 - (e) Lingnan Institute of Further Education;
 - (f) School of Continuing Education, Hong Kong Baptist University; and
 - (g) VTC School of Business and Information Systems
- to conduct a Learning Programme Re-accreditation exercise to assess and determine whether the Diploma Yi Jin programme continues to achieve the stated objectives and meet the Qualifications Framework (QF) standard at QF Level 3.
- 1.3 The accreditation exercise was conducted according to the relevant accreditation guidelines referred to in the Service Agreement and the Terms of Reference stated therein. Site visits took place on 5 – 22 April 2016.

2. HKCAAVQ's Accreditation Determination

Having due consideration of the accreditation panel's observations and comments as presented in this Report, HKCAAVQ makes the following accreditation determination:

FSTE should enhance the Professional Training Programme to include topics on curriculum planning, teaching methodologies and assessment design, in order to better prepare teaching staff, especially those without formal teacher training, for effective programme development and delivery. The newly included topics should be made available to both new and practicing DYJ teachers. 3. 8. The Operator should develop a more rigorous mechanism for the standardisation of assessments, in particular continuous assessments, across different classes and different cohorts to ensure consistency of learning outcomes.
9. The Operator should strengthen the class observation mechanism such that the performance of teaching staff is regularly monitored to ensure effective programme delivery.
10. The Operator should appoint an External Examiner with relevant subject expertise or professional experience for the Elective Clusters. The Operator is recommended to appoint more than one External Examiner with relevant subject expertise or professional experience for the Elective Cluster of Computer Security and Hardware System Management to provide effective input on the assessments.

13. The Operator should enhance staff development activities to ensure that the understanding of QF levels and standards of teaching staff and External Examiners are kept updated for performing their roles effectively.

14. The Operator should strengthen the class observation mechanism such that the performance of teaching staff is regularly monitored to ensure effective programme delivery.

3. Programme Details

The following is the programme information provided by the Operators.

3.1 Programme Objectives

- To provide an alternative pathway for secondary 6 school leavers under the New Academic Structure as well as adult learners aged 21 or above to obtain a formal qualification for the purposes of employment and further study;
- To equip students with an array of generic skills and general knowledge including basic language skills, information technology skills, mathematical reasoning skills and interpersonal skills, thereby enabling students to build a firm foundation in these aspects; and
- To strengthen students' motivation to study and facilitate students in developing self-learning skills for the pursuit of further study independently

3.2 Programme Intended Learning Outcomes

- Demonstrate functional competence in English and Chinese and be able to communicate their ideas effectively in both languages to other people;
- Apply numerical and information technology skills in daily life, employment and further study;
- Understand and critically reflect on contemporary issues that impact on daily life at personal, community, national and global levels;
- Actively pursue their academic and career aspirations and display positive attitudes towards work and learning;
- Work effectively, both independently and in collaboration with others, to solve problems encountered in life, work and study;
- Act responsibly as informed, civic-minded citizens of Hong Kong with a sense of personal worth and of their national and global identity; and

- Apply knowledge, skills and competencies in a specialized vocational domain to employment or further academic and professional development

3.4 Graduation Requirements

- An attendance rate of 80% or above in each of five Core and three Elective Courses; AND
- At least 50% overall marks in each of five Core and three Elective Courses.

3.5 Admission Requirements

a. Local students:

- (i) Hong Kong ID card holder; AND
- (ii) Completed Secondary 6 in HK or equivalent to 12 years of progressive study; OR
Aged 21 or above upon commencement of the first semester for mature students without Secondary 6 qualification.

b. Non-local students:

- (i) Whose immigration status permits them to study in HK; AND
- (ii) Fulfil the conditions stated in a. (ii) above.

4. Substantial Change

- 4.1 Maintenance of the HKCAAVQ accreditation status during the validity period is subject to no substantial change being made without prior approval by HKCAAVQ.

5. Qualifications Register

- 5.1 Qualifications accredited by HKCAAVQ are eligible for entry into the Qualifications Register (QR) at <http://www.hkqr.gov.hk> for recognition under the Qualifications Framework (QF). Operators should apply separately to have their quality-assured qualifications entered into the QR.
- 5.2 Only learners who are admitted to the named accredited learning programme during the validity period and who have graduated with the named qualification uploaded in the QR will be considered to have acquired a qualification recognised under the QF.
