1. TERMS OF REFERENCE

1.1 Based on the Service Agreement (No.: VA972), the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ), in the capacity of the Accreditation Authority as provided for under the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Ordinance (Cap 592) (AAVQO), was commissioned by the Clothing Industry Training Authority (Operator) to conduct a Learning Programme Re-accreditation Exercise with the following Terms of Reference:

- (a) To conduct an accreditation test as provided for in AAVQO to determine whether the programmes of the Clothing Industry Training Authority (the Operator) meets the stated objectives and QF Level 3 standard and can be offered as accredited programmes
 - (i) Diploma in Fashion Creation Technology; and
 - (ii) Diploma in Fashion Product Development;
- (b) To issue to the Operator accreditation report setting out the results of the determination in relation to (a) by HKCAAVQ.

1.2 The accreditation exercise was conducted according to the relevant accreditation guidelines referred to in the Service Agreement. A site visit took place on 31 May 2019.

2. HKCAAVQ'S DETERMINATION

The Operator should clearly outline the criteria for passing the admission test and interview in the internal guidelines to ensure admission staff maintain consistency in the learner selection process for the programmes. 2. The Operator should include the criteria of vetting and approval for module exemption through the Credit Accumulation and Transfer policy in related programme documents to ensure consistency in implementation of module exemption. 3. The Operator should avoid arranging learners of programmes other than Diploma in Fashion Creation Technology and Diploma in Fashion Product Development in the same classes. 4. The Operator should consider incorporating integrated learning

opportunities, such as industry project, in the programme structure for consolidation of learning in individual modules in the Fashion industry context.

5. The Operator should improve the feedback collection mechanism and documentation system to close the loop in the quality assurance process.

3. INTRODUCTION

The Clothing Industry Training Authority (CITA) was established in September 1975 according to the Industry Training (Clothing Industry) Ordinance to provide training courses for the clothing and textile industry. CITA currently provides various part-time and full-time programmes for secondary school graduates and industry practitioners. The Initial Evaluation status of CITA was granted in March 2014.

4. PROGRAMME DETAILS

The following is the programme information provided by the Operator.

4.1 Programme Objectives

Diploma in Fashion Creation Technology

The programme equips students with technical competence in fashion clothing creation (cut and sewn). Students will learn about the technical knowledge in the area of textile materials, pattern design and clothing production.

Diploma in Fashion Product Development

The programme equips students with competence in developing fashion products that are commercially and technical viable. Students will learn the latest knowledge and skills in the area of textile materials, fashion design, pattern design, clothing production and computer application.

4.2 Programme Intended Learning Outcomes

Diploma in Fashion Creation Technology

Upon completion of the Programme, learners should be able to:

- demonstrate an understanding of the professional practice in fashion industry;
- demonstrate an awareness of technical issues in relation to fashion clothing creation (pattern construction and clothing production); and
- use a common language for effective communication among different parties of the fashion supply chain.

Diploma in Fashion Product Development

Upon completion of the Programme, learners should be able to:

- demonstrate an understanding of the professional practice in fashion industry ;
- demonstrate an ability to create marketable and producible fashion designs;
- demonstrate an ability to transform (or realise) fashion design ideas into products; and
- use a common language for effective communication among different parties of the fashion supply chain.

4.4 Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate, a learner must attain:

- an attendance rate of 70% or above in all modules; and
- at least 50% overall marks in all modules.

4.5 Admission Requirements

- Completion of secondary education or equivalent; OR
- Mature applicants over the age of 23 with at least 2 years of relevant work experience and a pass in admission test and/or interview will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

5. IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THIS ACCREDITATION REPORT

5.1 Variation and withdrawal of this Accreditation Report

5.1.1 This Accreditation Report is issued pursuant to section 5 of the AAVQO, and contains HKCAAVQ's substantive determination regarding the accreditation, including the validity period as well as any conditions and restrictions subject to which the determination is to have effect.

5.1.2 HKCAAVQ may subsequently decide to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report if it is satisfied that any of the grounds set out in section 5 (2) of the AAVQO apply. This includes where HKCAAVQ is satisfied that the Operator is no longer competent to achieve the relevant objectives and/or the Programme no longer meets the standard to achieve the relevant objectives as claimed by the Operator (whether by reference to the Operator's failure to fulfil any conditions and/or comply with any restrictions stipulated in this Accreditation Report or otherwise) or where at any time during the validity period there has/have been substantial change(s) introduced by the Operator after HKCAAVQ has issued the accreditation report(s) to the Operator and which has/have not been approved by HKCAAVQ. Please refer to the '*Guidance Notes on Substantial Change to Accreditation Status*' in seeking

approval for proposed changes. These Guidance Notes can be downloaded from the HKCAAVQ website.

- 5.1.3 If HKCAAVQ decides to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report, it will give the Operator notice of such variation or withdrawal pursuant to section 5(4) of the AAVQO.
- 5.1.4 The accreditation status of the Operator and/or Programme will lapse immediately upon the expiry of the validity period or upon the issuance of a notice of withdrawal of this Accreditation Report.

5.2 Appeals

- 5.2.1 If the Operator is aggrieved by the determination made in this Accreditation Report, then pursuant to Part 3 of the AAVQO the Operator has a right of appeal to the Appeal Board. Any appeal must be lodged within 30 days of the receipt of this Accreditation Report.
- 5.2.2 If the Operator is aggrieved by a decision to vary or withdraw this Accreditation Report, then pursuant to Part 3 of the AAVQO the Operator has a right of appeal to the Appeal Board. Any appeal must be lodged within 30 days of the receipt of the Notice of Variation or Withdrawal.
- 5.2.3 The Operator should be aware that a notice of variation or withdrawal of this Accreditation Report is not itself an accreditation report and the right to appeal against HKCAAVQ's substantive determination regarding accreditation arises only from this Accreditation Report.

5.3 Qualifications Register

- 5.3.1 Qualifications accredited by HKCAAVQ are eligible for entry into the Qualifications Register ("QR") at www.hkqr.gov.hk for recognition under the QF. The Operator should apply separately to have their quality-assured qualifications entered into the QR.
- 5.3.2 Only learners who commence the study of the named accredited learning programme during the validity period and who have graduated with the named qualification listed in the QR will be considered to have acquired a qualification recognised under the QF.
