This accreditation report is issued by the Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) in its capacity as the Accreditation Authority as provided for under the Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications Ordinance (Cap 592) (AAVQO). This report outlines the HKCAAVQ's determination, the validity period of the determination as well as any conditions or restrictions on the determination.

## 1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Yi Jin Diploma (YJD) programme was accredited by the HKCAAVQ in August 2013 with a validity period of three years starting from the 2013/14 academic year to be operated by seven member institutions of the Federation for Self-financing Tertiary Education (FSTE) including the Li Ka Shing Institute of Professional and Continuing Education, The Open University of Hong Kong (LiPACE/the Operator). At the time of the accreditation exercise for the YJD programme, the HKCAAVQ was informed that the FSTE member institutions may propose new and/or revamped Elective Clusters before commencement of each academic year.
- 1.2 For implementation in the 2015/16 academic year, LiPACE proposed an Elective Cluster, Fashion Make-up and Creative Styling [時尚化妝與創意造型], which was developed with reference to the Specification of Competency Standards (SCS) developed by the Beauty and Hairdressing Industry Training Advisory Committee of the Qualifications Framework (QF) and the Qualifications Guidelines for the SCS-based Courses under the QF.
- 1.3 Following the advice of the Education Bureau to the FSTE and its member institutions to award standalone qualifications to YJD students on successful completion of a SCS-based Elective Cluster/Course, this Elective Cluster of LiPACE is to be accredited by the HKCAAVQ leading to the SCS-based qualification, Certificate in Fashion Make-up and Creative Styling (Elective Cluster of Yi Jin Diploma) [時尚化妝與創意造型（毅進文憑選修群組）證書] and to be uploaded separately on the Qualifications Register of the QF. On successful completion of the Elective Cluster, students of the YJD programme will be awarded the Certificate in Fashion Make-up and Creative Styling (Elective Cluster of Yi Jin Diploma).
- 1.4 Based on the agreement, the HKCAAVQ was commissioned by the FSTE to assess and determine whether the Certificate in Fashion Make-up and Creative Styling (Elective Cluster of Yi Jin Diploma) of the LiPACE achieves the stated objectives and meets the QF standard at QF Level 3.
- 1.5 The accreditation exercise was conducted according to the relevant accreditation guidelines referred to in the agreement and the terms stated therein.

### 3. Programme Details

The following is the programme information provided by the Operator.

#### 3.1 Programme Objectives

This programme aims to provide students with fundamental knowledge of cosmetology and make-up and correct valuation as well as proper attitude. It aims to enlighten students on basic knowledge and skills of make-up and styling, e.g., fashion make-up, creative make-up, stage/photography/movie and special make-up and styling, etc. Meanwhile, the provided education and training is to improve students' academic level and qualification for their good preparation on career attitude, knowledge and skills to join in the industry and further studies.

### 3.2 Programme Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the programme, students should be able to:

- State correct professional attitude of make-up artist and the safety knowledge of cosmetology industry;
- Recognize the basic knowledge of skin care, cosmetology and colour theory on make-up;
- Apply creative fashion make-up knowledge and skills to design the fashion image for different requirement;
- Compare the relationship between different performances, stage design and stage make-up/styling;
- Apply general special make-up skills to create character image;
- Apply stage make-up and styling skills on required stage styles.
